Topic: Proposed Walking Trails

<u>Issue & Analysis:</u> At the August 6, 2016 Trails Committee meeting, the committee made a motion to construct two new walking trails with parking areas. Trail #1 is located just north of Pioneer Drive and trail #2 is located north of General Jackson. Both trails are located off of the existing trail system. Parking areas have been staked at both locations. The details of the two trails can be found in the attached power point presentation from the Engineering Department at the University of Wisconsin-Platteville.

The estimated cost of materials for the construction of the two trails is \$2,000. The existing budget for trail work and pathways will cover the cost of this project. This includes gravel, possibly a couple of small culverts, signage, and picnic tables or benches. All tree removal and construction will be done by maintenance staff and equipment. This project will be completed late fall into winter and will take around 3-4 weeks to complete using a two-man crew. We currently have mulch, boulders, and fill around the property that can be utilized at no additional cost.

<u>Recommendation:</u> To authorize the construction of two new walking trails as proposed by the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. All work will be done in-house by the Maintenance Department.
